

Jemena owns and operates a diverse portfolio of energy transportation assets across the east coast of Australia. With more than \$12.4 billion worth of major utility infrastructure, we supply millions of households and businesses with these essential services every day.

Jemena is proposing an expansion of the Northern Trunkline of its New South Wales gas distribution network so that it can bring new sources of gas to Sydney and Newcastle.

What is the Hunter Lateral Project?

The proposed Hunter Lateral Project involves the construction of a 6km buried pipeline which will connect Santos's proposed Hunter Gas Pipeline at Millers Forest to the Jemena Gas Networks (JGN) Northern Trunkline at Hexham.

Where is the gas coming from?

The proposed Hunter Lateral Project will connect to the proposed Santos Hunter Gas Pipeline at Millers Forest. The Hunter Gas Pipeline plans to deliver gas from Santos Narrabri Gas Project to the east coast domestic market. Where will the pipeline and metering station be built?

The proposed pipeline will be buried and located between Jemena's existing Northern Trunkline at Hexham and the termination point for the Hunter Gas Pipeline located at Millers Forest. Refer to overview map.

Metering and pressure regulation facilities are also proposed at the termination of the Hunter Gas Pipeline at Millers Forest.

When will the new pipeline be built?

Jemena currently expects construction of the pipeline to commence in 2026, with a commissioning date in 2027, subject to approvals being sought.

Jemena will work closely with affected landholders and stakeholders to ensure they are informed as the proposed Hunter Lateral Project develops.

Does Jemena own other pipelines?

Yes. Jemena owns a number of other gas pipelines in Australia, including in Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and the Northern Territory.

In New South Wales, Jemena owns and operates the gas distribution networks in Sydney and Newcastle, delivering gas to 1.5 million customers including local businesses industrial users and residential customers across the state.


In addition to these Northern and Southern Trunklines associated with the Jemena Gas Networks, Jemena also own and operate the following major gas transmission pipelines in NSW:

- the Eastern Gas Pipeline, which transports gas between Victoria's Gippsland and New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory; and
- The Port Kembla Lateral, which will transports gas from the Port Kembla Energy Terminal to Jemena's Eastern Gas Pipeline.
